- 1. A Glock Pistol with no modifications other than sights of external cosmetics. Pistols with internal or
- 2. external modifications that could render the pistol less safe that it was originally produced are not allowed.
- 3. A <u>strong side</u>, <u>belt support holster which covers the trigger and trigger guard</u>. Duty Holsters are highly encouraged but no required.
- 4. Magazine carrier(s) with or without flaps, capable of carrying two magazines.
- 5. 3 magazines
- 6. A belt capable of supporting the weight of the holster, pistol and magazines
- 7. Eye protections, hearing protection and a hat or ball cap with a brim or bill to prevent fired cases from landing behind shooters glasses.
- 8. <u>1000 rounds of factory loaded ammunition</u> of the proper caliber.
