Structure Analysis and Search Warrants

COURSE CONTENT: During criminal investigations officers may need to serve a search warrant at a location where the interior layout is unknown. When the target structure's layout is unknown, Officer safety is compromised and the probability of evidence being destroyed rises. Officers need to know where to go upon entry so they can quickly secure the occupants and prevent the loss of evidence.

Officers will be trained to generally recognize how the interior of a structure is laid out by identifying the common outside characteristics of structures. These features give an overview of the common characteristics that identify where bedrooms, kitchens, bathrooms and other areas of a home are located.

Officers will participate in case studies before going hands-on outside of the classroom, where they will practice documenting structures to identify the likely interior layouts.

Officers should bring clothing adequate for the outside weather that day, along with a pencil and notepad for sketching.
