DOMESTIC VIOLENCE-FAMILY LAW ANALYSIS

This presentation has been modified to analyze the **Key Psychology of Domestic Violence Training Guidelines** mandated by the Training Standards Board as required by Public Act 99-0810 – Eff: 1-1-17. It will feature an analysis of the current Illinois law with respect to the duties, authorities and responsibilities of Illinois Law Enforcement Officers concerning **Family Law** and **Domestic Violence**. An analysis of the current status of the various orders of protection and the rights of victims of domestic violence will be given. Featured will be an analysis of the current **Illinois Domestic Violence Act** and related statutory provisions. Additionally, an analysis of Law Enforcement duties and responsibilities of the new **Firearms Restraining Order Act** will be provided and discussed. [**NOTE:** Pursuant to Public Act: 102-0345 – Eff: 6-1-22, every law enforcement officer must receive annual **Firearms Restraining Order** training.]. Emphasis will be given to issues of **Crisis Intervention** and **De-escalation Training**. [The **Key Crisis Intervention Training Guidelines** will be analyzed.]. Included will be discussions of the most recent legislation and case law dealing with these topics.
