## 40 hr. Firearms Instructor Training

**DATES:** July 25-28, 2022 (ten-hour days)

**Day 1- Officers must qualify on their 1<sup>st</sup> attempt of the 50 round course to remain in the class**

This is not a learn to shoot class, it is a learn to coach & teach course.

The proposed Instructor must be able to effectively teach/present an assigned topic during this class

**Course Content:** Through lecture, demonstration and practical exercises, the Firearms instructor will have the knowledge and ability to do the following:

- ~ Be well versed in the use of "Deadly Force"
- ~ Instruct firearms safety
- ~ Instruct gun handling skills
- ~ Conduct firearms training / qualification for all officers
- ~ Instruct basic marksmanship skills
- ~ Operate a range safely
- ~ Maintain firearms training records

### Topics will include:

- ~ Nomenclature & weapons maintenance
- ~ Modern technique: Grip-Stance-Sight alignment
- ~ Use of Force
- ~ Low light shooting techniques
- ~ Rifle familiarization
- ~ Basic gun handling skills
- ~ Malfunction drills, Tac load, Shot analysis
- ~ Shoot positions
- ~ Combat shooting & moving, speed drills
- ~ Instructor development

The student will be expected to pass a written examination (70%), present a block of instruction to fellow students, and shoot a qualification score of 80% or better on the (50) rd. State of Illinois course of fire.

### **Students will need the following equipment:**

- Eye and Ear protection (mandatory)
- 500 rounds handgun ammunition
- Flashlight
- Duty handgun - 3 magazines and gun belt
- 20 rounds, .223 ammunition (gun not provided)
