## School Resource Officer 16 Hour Refresher

**PURPOSE OF COURSE:** This 2 day, 16 hour program has been designed by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training Standards Board to provide students with the required training in use of police personnel within the school setting in accordance with SB 2925 (PA 100-984). SROs must be police officers of law enforcement agencies who are to serve within a school setting pursuant to a memorandum of understanding between the employing law enforcement agency and a school district within the agency's jurisdiction. Any officer serving in this role as of January 1, 2021 must have a special certification issued by the Illinois Law Enforcement Training and Standards Board ("Board"). **Such officers must have attended a special training, or attained a waiver by the Board before they can serve in this role.**

This classroom 2L6 is located inside and to the back of the Sauk Valley Cafeteria. The cafeteria is located towards the East end of the college and Officers should park in the East parking lot and enter through the front facing Dillon Lobby doors. The cafeteria is just above this lobby on the second floor.
