One of the key elements of success in a field training program is program management. Often programs will train the FTO but fail to prepare the supervisor for the variety of tasks required to properly coordinate, administrate, and lead the field training unit. This course will prepare the Field Training Manger (FTM) and Field Training Coordinator (FTC) for the requirements of their positions.

- C. Describe the importance of Leadership in FT Program

- G. Describe the importance of proper management and selection of the FTO
- H. List legal issues regarding Field Training Programs
