To successfully complete this class, students must:

Pass a written exam with a minimum score of 80% correct and demonstrate some physical aptitude in the practical exercise while maintaining a safe environment.

The purpose of this class is to acquaint students with the various models of GLOCK handguns and how to properly maintain, service & repair those firearms.

Students will be given all necessary class materials and tools along with a GLOCK Pistol. The instructor will give directions and demonstrate how to unload, load, field strip, detail strip, clean, lubricate, troubleshoot and replace parts. The instructor will make suggestions about setting up a proper firearms maintenance plan and respond to any questions the students may submit.

Students must bring safety glasses and a small flashlight
